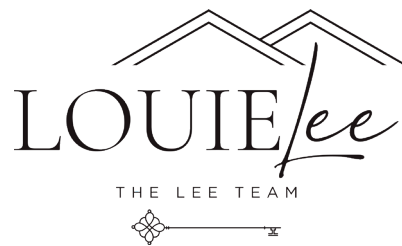
Benefiting A Precious Child
