The Ladies 9 in the Pines is swinging into action with

its annual golf tournament fundraiser to support the fight against breast cancer. The Country Club at Castle Pines hosts the event, which

is slated for October 2, 2025.

The tournament started out by donating funds to national breast cancer organizations. That changed in 2020, when Louise Melbye, past president of the Ladies 9 and chair of the golf tournament, along with Marcy Blair, a fellow Village resident, committee member and breast cancer survivor,

spearheaded a change to direct the fundraising to the Castle Rock community.

Since 2020, the tournament has raised more than \$700,000 to support the Breast Care Center, at AdventHealth Castle Rock, a non-profit hospital.

"Marcy and I decided in 2020 to switch it around and make it local," Melbye said. "We are so proud of our fund for free mammograms for low-income and underinsured women in the Castle Rock community."

In addition to providing the funding for mammograms, the group contributes funds to the Breast Care Center at AdventHealth. Money raised has been used to purchase new state of the art equipment for biopsies, automated ultrasound and advanced diagnostic machines helping to create

one of the best breast care centers in the entire state.

- In Colorado, about 5,150 new cases of breast cancer will be diagnosed in women,

and about 700 women will die of the disease.
